Project Description:

The American Express Plantation Facility Project involved the reconfiguration of the existing 15.6-acre parking lot. Work included the restriping of the entire parking area to meet current code requirements, the relocation of all on-site ADA spaces and access ramps to service spaces, the redesign of existing landscape islands, the relocation of existing striping and signage, the installation of new curbing and sidewalks, and the modification of existing entrance features. To finalize the construction plan development coordination and approval from the City's Site Plan and Zoning review committees were obtained. Total design costs for the project, including survey, was \$75,000. The project began in 2012 and was completed within 6 months without liquidated damages.
